ABOUT THE OUTDOOR ART & HERITAGE SHOW

The Outdoor Art & Heritage Show (OAHS) is part of Southern Illinois' Celebration of National Hunting and Fishing Day held annually at John A. Logan College on the fourth weekend of September. The OAHS takes place in the College gymnasium.

The purpose of the show is to promote artistic, cultural, and natural history activities that relate to outdoor recreation. Artists, museums, authors, taxidermists, collectors and many others are invited to enter the show. They may display and sell artwork, provide information about their services and programs, and give demonstrations among other activities. Exhibitors will have access to the 20,000 to 30,000 individuals who visit the event every year.

Time-specific activities such as seminars, musical performances, etc., will take place in a designated area within the .
